- Ability to meet the physical demands of the position. This may include standing for long periods, ability to bend and lift, exposure to noise and weather elements, etc.
- Must have good personal hygiene and adhere to dress-code.
- Safe Food Handler Certificate required for some locations. Successful applicants in food service will be supported to complete this training.
- Criminal records check with vulnerable sector check required for some locations. Successful applications must have this completed before starting work.
